## NORTHWOODS HUNTER/JUMPER CIRCUIT RULES

- First to Sixth place ribbons will be awarded for each class
  - Champion and Reserve will be awarded in each division at every show. To be eligible you must enter and compete in entire division.
  - USEF rules apply if not specifically addressed in this program.
  - Proper show attire is required. Exceptions made for lead line and walk/trot classes.
  - Judge may waive coats if hot weather compromises rider safety.
  - No cell phone use in warm up arena.
  - Any rider under 18 in the warm up arena must be accompanied by trainer or responsible adult. Trainer or responsible adult must be 18 years+.
  - All riders **MUST** wear protective headgear securely fastened at all times while mounted.
  - Show management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes with less than 3 entries.
  - Poor sportsmanship will not be permitted. This includes abuse of horse and excessive obscene language as determined by show managers. Each individual must respect the spirit of good horsemanship. No horse shall be reprimanded ahead of girth or struck more than three times (on hindquarters) with stick. If this occurs, rider will be excused from ring immediately and disqualified from current class.
  - The judge's decision is final
  - Stallions must be handled by adults (18 years and over).
  - All dogs must be kept on leashes and secured at all times.
  - Current negative Coggins required with entry for all horses.
  - Pre-Entry Refunds – 1 week prior to show with veterinary certificate for lame or sick horse or doctor's note for injured or sick competitors.
  - Equitation points count for the rider only, regardless of the horse/rider combination.
  - Hunter points will count towards horse.
  - In Gates areas are reserved for show management, trainers and competitors in current class. In gate area must be kept clear of congestion to assure safety for horses, riders, trainers, show management and spectators.
  - Riders may enter one Equitation division and one Medal class. Year-end awards will be given in both Medal divisions and in the Equitation Divisions.
  - Hunters may only cross enter within the next sequential height division.
- Year End Awards**
- Prizes will be awarded for each division including medal (except lead line and dressage).
  - Competitor's Circuit fees must be paid prior to showing in order for the points to count toward year end.
  - Equitation points count for the rider only, regardless of the horse/rider combination.
  - Hunter points count for the horse/rider combination.
  - Year end awards will be presented at a banquet with location, date, and time yet to be determined.
  - Northwood's Hunter-Jumper college scholarship will be presented at the banquet.

**MEMBERSHIP FEES:**

- One horse/rider combination: \$30.00
- Rider Only – EQ/Medal: \$20.00
- Horse Only – Multiple Hunters: \$40.00
- This is for any horse being ridden by more than one rider or for any rider competing on multiple horses.

\*Circuit fees must be paid prior to showing in order for the points to count toward year end award.

**HORSESHOW FEES:**

- Office Fee- \$10/entry (horse/rider combination)
- Hunter Classes - \$10/class or \$25/division
- Equitation Classes - \$10/class
- Medal Classes - \$20/class (\$10 will go towards NHJC award fund)
- Jumper Classes - \$10/class
- Dressage - \$10/class
- Stall Fee: Must be made prior to show date with pre-registration
  - a) Weekend Rental - \$80 - \$20 refund to be mailed for stripped stalls
  - b) Daily Rental \$50/night - \$10 refund to be mailed for stripped stalls
- \*Daily rate 4:00p.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Haul in Fee - \$15/day per horse – Tie to Trailer/Portable Stall
- Camping Fee - \$15/night. Rustic Camping
- Bedding - \$7/bag
- Insufficient Funds - \$25 fee for returned checks. Anyone not in good standing with any one of the circuit shows will be suspended from competition until check is made good.
- Post Entry Fee - \$5 per registration. Applies if registration is received after the closing date. Competitors may forgo pre-registration and enter on the day of showing in which case, the \$5 fee will be applied. A registration constitutes one horse/rider combination.

**CLASS RULES  
Hunter Divisions**

**Lead Line:** Open to any horse and rider. Rider may not cross enter into any other class.

**Walk-Trot:** Open to any horse and rider. **Rider may not cross enter into any other division.**

**Cross Rail Hunter:** Open to any horse/rider combination. The 2008 Year End Champion in this division will not be allowed to compete in this division or lower height division in 2009.

**Long/Short Stirrup Hunter:** Jump heights 1'6". Open to any horse/rider combination. The 2008 Year End Champion in this division will not be allowed to compete in this division or lower height division in 2009.

**Barely Vertical Hunter:** Jump heights 2'0". Open to any horse/rider combination.

**Pony Hunter:** Jump heights 2'0". Pony Height must be 14.2 HH (58") and under. Ponies may be measured on the show grounds.

**Limit Hunter:** Jump heights 2'3". The judge may call back the top competitors who will jog their horses into the ring for soundness check and horsemanship assessment.

**Low Hunter:** Jump heights 2'6". The judge may call back the top competitors who will jog their horses into the ring for soundness check and horsemanship assessment.

**2'9 Working Hunter:** Jump heights 2'9". The judge may call back the top competitors who will jog their horses into the ring for soundness check and horsemanship assessment.

**3'0 Working Hunter:** Jump heights 3'0". The judge may call back the top competitors who will jog their horses into the ring for soundness check and horsemanship assessment.

**Equitation Divisions**

Judged on correct rider position. Except for refusals, jumping faults of the horse are not to be considered unless it is the result of the rider's ability.

**Cross Rail:** Open to any horse/rider combination. All jumps will be simple cross rails with simple course designs. The Year End Champion in this division is not eligible for future year ends in this division.

**Long/Short Stirrup:** Jump heights 1'6". The Year End Champion in this division will not be eligible for future year end awards in this division.

**Children/Adult 2'0":** Jump heights 2'0". Open to any horse/rider combination.

**Children/Adult 2'3":** Jump heights 2'3". Open to any horse/rider combination.

**Children/Adult 2'6":** Jump heights 2'6". Open to any horse/rider combination.

**Children/Adult 2'9":** Jump heights 2'9". Open to any horse/rider combination.

**Children/Adult 3'0":** Jump heights 3'0". Open to any horse/rider combination.

**Miscellaneous Divisions/Classes**

**Lead Line:** Open to any horse/rider combination. *Rider may not cross enter into any other class.*

**Walk/Trot:** Open to any horse/rider combination. *Rider may not cross enter into any other division.* Walk/Trot division combines equitation and hunter.

**Medal Classes:** Classes judged on equitation over a more difficult course, which will include at least 1 roll back turn and more difficult jumps. Jumps may include triple bars, liverpools, skinny fences and various types of oxers. Exhibitors are asked to perform a test or asked horsemanship questions, which will be determined by the judge. A rider may only enter 1 medal class at the same height as chosen equitation division.
